

TEEN BOARD GUIDELINES

Structure:

- 2 Students, male & female, chosen from the congregation of each current ERLTC Board member
- Students are to be chosen for upcoming year convention immediately after current year convention is completed
- The Senior will serve 1 year and the Junior will serve 2 years. That way there will be ½ the Teen Board familiar with the process each year.
- Students are chosen by silent vote of their congregation peers. LTC Coordinator of the individual congregation has the authority to void any votes they feel necessary but will not be a common practice
- Once the board is chosen they will decide who will serve as Chairman, Co-Chairman & Secretary

Requirement:

- Student must be in the 11th & 12th Grade
- Exceptions to the structure and requirements can be decided by the individual LTC Church Coordinator subject to the needs of their congregation
- Student must be actively participating in LTC within their congregation
- Student must be willing to serve on the Teen Board for the current years convention and able to work their schedule to attend 2 (or # decided by ERLTC Board) future schedule Board meetings
- Student understands that their participation on the Teen Board will require some active responsibility for the Convention to be determined by the ERLTC Board

Purpose:

- Give our youth an avenue to share their voice through the Teen Board to the ERLTC Board
- Give our youth the opportunity to meet and create a bond with other youth from participating congregations
- Brain storm ways to bring the youth of our Lord's church together more so to create stronger bonds and love for each other through understanding of spiritual differences.
- Learn to take more responsibility and act on it for their spiritual growth and develop relationships with other adult Christians so they will have some loving guidance.
- Grow in maturity to understand that we should love others with gentle concern for their spiritual life
- Desire to work together with our Christian brothers and sisters with understanding and flexibility according to each others spiritual walk.
